

LAPD Sued for Discrimination and Retaliation; Officer Alleges She Was Stalked by Assistant Chief Alfred Labrada

<u>Our firm filed a governmental claim</u> (the precursor to a formal lawsuit) against the LAPD on behalf of an officer who alleges she was harassed when a Deputy Chief surreptitiously placed an Apple tracker on her car, and then was discriminated and retaliated against after filing a report that she was being stalked by the Chief. Despite assurances that her complaint and internal investigations would be kept confidential (which they are required to be), the Plaintiff was contacted by multiple officers throughout the department within 24 hours asking, "Are the rumors true?" This matter was covered by multiple media outlets such as <u>CBS</u> <u>News</u>, <u>Los Angeles Times</u>, <u>MyNewsLA</u> and more.

On Oct. 27, **the trial court upheld the \$2.8M verdict we secured** on behalf of Riverside Motor Officer Shawn Casteel following a month-long trial against the City of Riverside. Casteel, who bravely spoke out against unlawful citation and arrest quotas, remains vindicated. We are now filing our motion for attorney fees as allowed by the whistleblower statute, which will add significant value to the overall recovery, pushing the total close to \$4 million.
